Between 2010 and 2014, more than 11,700 cases of such violence were reported to the police in the United Kingdom alone, according to Freedom of Information data obtained by the London-based Iranian and Kurdish Women's Rights Organisation (IKWRO); globally, two thirds of victims (93 percent of whom were women) were killed by their families of origin.

Political, social and cultural oppression can involve multiple jurisdictions and languages with victims spread across multiple countries and continents.
